Pricing & Ticketing Information

The Group Rate for groups of 25 or more people visiting Saturday, May 2 - Sunday, May 17 or Saturday, September 12 - Sunday, September 27, 2020 is \$23.00, plus tax, per person and includes entry into the Park and Unlimited Rides during your visit.

The Group Rate for groups of 25 or more people visiting Saturday, May 23 through Monday, September 7, 2020 is \$30.00, plus tax, per person and includes entry into the Park and Unlimited Rides in the Amusement and Water Parks during your visit.

In order to qualify for the Group Rate, a minimum of 25 people between ages 3-59 is required to receive the Group Rate. One payment, in full, must be received for the entire group.

Your group must have at least 25 people between the ages of 3-59 to make your group and receive the discounted Group Rate. Once you have your initial 25 people, anyone ages 1-2 or 60 and older will receive the further-discounted Child/Senior rate.

Lake Winnepesaukah does not offer gate admission, general admission, or non-rider fees. Everyone who wishes to enter the Park must purchase a Ride Pass, for their respective age group, in order to enter the Park. Lake Winnepesaukah does not offer complimentary Ride Passes.

There are no refunds or rainchecks on tickets, Ride Passes, or catered meals. Tickets, Rides Passes, and catered meal tickets are non-transferable and only valid on the day of your visit.

Group Payment Method & Information

Payment for your group's visit is due upon receipt. Lake Winnepesaukah does not accept personal checks or purchase orders as payment methods. Acceptable payment methods include: Credit Card (VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express), or Cashier's Check/Money Order/Organization Check (make checks payable to Lake Winnepesaukah).

Lake Winnepesaukah will only accept one (1) payment in full for the entire group. Individual transactions/payments will not be accepted for the Group Rate.

Non-Profit & Tax Exempt Groups

Because Lake Winnie is physically located in the state of Georgia, we are only able to accept Georgia's ST-5 Certificate of Exemption. Tax exempt status only applies to groups/organizations with this form. If your group/organization has this completed form, please provide a copy of this document, in advance, prior to your visit. Federal tax-exempt forms cannot be accepted. Catered meals are not tax exempt. Tax exemption does not apply at the Gate the day of your visit.

Weather Policies & Procedures

For the safety and convenience all guests, Lake Winnepesaukah has access to comprehensive regional forecasts.

If we experience a drizzle to light rain, it will not drastically affect our operation. Should the weather become more intense e.g. thunder, lightning, high winds, heavy rain, etc. some rides will shut down to let the weather clear. When it is considered safe, rides and attractions that shut down because of the weather will reopen.

Please keep in mind, when dealing with the weather, each situation and forecast is unique.

Once tickets are purchased, Lake Winnepesaukah does not offer refunds or rainchecks.

Group Rate Frequently Asked Questions



Q: How do we get the Group Rate?

A: A minimum of 25 people between ages 3-59 is required to receive the Group Rate. One payment, in full, must be received for the entire group. The Group Rate changes throughout the season. If you are visiting May 2-22 or September 12 through October 31, the Group Rate will be \$23.00, per person, plus tax. If you are visiting May 23 through September 7, the Group Rate will be \$30.00, per person, plus tax.

Q: How do I prepay for my Group's tickets?

A: Group Leaders can purchase tickets online by visiting www.lakewinnie.com. The Group Rate is available online and at the Gate the day of your visit.

Q: We have some Seniors 60+ and/or children ages 1-2. How do those discounted rates work with the Group Rate?

A: You need 25 people between the ages of 3-59 to make your group and get the Group Rate. Once you have your initial 25, anyone 1-2 or 60+ will receive the discounted Child/Senior rate.

Q: We have a lot of children in our Group. Do they need a chaperone?

A: Lake Winnepesaukah requires children under the age of 16 to be accompanied by a responsible adult for the entire length of their visit.

Q: There are some people coming in from out of town or meeting us at the Park. How do they get their tickets? Do they buy them when they get there?

A: Individual transactions are not accepted for the Group Rate. If you are bringing a large group, we suggest purchasing your tickets in advance and distributing them. You can always meet group members at the Front Gate to hand out tickets.

Q: There are some people who are coming to enjoy the day, but not interested in riding anything. What kind of ticket do they purchase?

A: Lake Winnepesaukah does not offer non-rider fees, general admission, or Gate admission. Every guest is required to purchase an Unlimited Ride Pass in order to enter the Park. NO exceptions.

Q: I'm bringing a rather large group. Do we get any complimentary passes?

A: No. Lake Winnie does not offer complimentary passes.

Q: We are a non-profit group. Will this trip be tax exempt?

A: Because Lake Winnie is physically located in the state of Georgia, we are only able to accept Georgia's ST-5 Certificate of Exemption. If your organization has this form, please let us know in advance. Federal tax-exempt forms cannot be accepted. Catered meals are not tax-exempt.

Q: Where exactly is Lake Winnie located?

A: Our physical address is 1730 Lakeview Drive in Rossville, GA 30741. Lake Winnie is in the Eastern Time Zone.

Q: What time does the Park open?

A: Please see our operating schedule at www.lakewinnie.com. For further assistance, please call 706-866-5681.

Q: What is your dress code?

A: It is important to dress appropriately for the weather and day's activities. Tops, bottoms, and shoes are required in the Amusement Park at all times during your visit. It is best to wear tennis shoes or other closed-toe shoes while in the Park. Swimsuits are **required** for SOAKya Water Park.

Q: Can we grill while we're there?

A: NO. Lake Winnepesaukah does not allow grilling or food preparation of any kind on the property. Grills, Crock Pots, chaffing dishes, warming trays, hot plates, electric cook tops, slow cookers, etc. are not permitted. **Nothing** that produces heat or has an open-flame is allowed. Sharp items, such as knives, are not allowed.

Q: How do I get a Picnic Pavilion?

A: Picnic space is based on availability and is subject to change. Picnic Pavilions and tables are on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Q: Can we bring a cooler into the Park? Can we bring food from home?

A: Yes. Coolers are allowed in the Park, but must stay in the Picnic Grounds. We suggest bringing a cold, homemade picnic lunch and plenty of water to drink. We do not allow outside caterers or commercially prepared food - meaning, no McDonald's, Taco Bell, KFC, Pizza Hut, etc. is allowed.

Q: Can Lake Winnie provide lunch?

A: For groups of 50 people or more, catered lunches are available. Meals start at \$4.00, per person, plus tax. **Catered meals require at least 2 weeks notice prior to your visit. Payment for meals is due 2 weeks prior to your visit.**

Q: It's time to head home. Will you make an announcement to let our group know?

A: It is up to the Group Leader to make a departure plan. We suggest having a group meeting place within the Park and telling everyone what time they should gather. Please remember that Lake Winnepesaukah is in the Eastern Time Zone.
